

**CITY OF SANGER**  
**EMERGENCY SERVICES DIRECTOR EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-04**  
**RELATING TO THE FULL LIFTING OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS WITHIN THE CITY**  
**OF SANGER CITY LIMITS**

As the Director of Emergency Services pursuant to Sanger City Code Chapter 26, Article I, and by the powers vested in me by Sanger City Code Section 26-6, I hereby issue the following orders, to be effective immediately and for so long as the City’s declared emergency is in effect related to COVID-19:

Given current rates of disease transmission in some counties, the Governor for the State of California along with the California Department of Public Health have confirmed its retirement of the Blueprint for a Safer Economy on June 15, 2021. These changes include the full opening of businesses with no capacity limits or distancing requirements, including the County of Fresno and the City of Sanger.

1. This order is issued as a result of the recent changes made by the Governor of California, which includes the retirement of the Blueprint for a Safer Economy. Restaurants, shopping malls, movie theaters, and most everyday places are now allowed to operate as normal – with no capacity limits or physical distancing required.
2. Masking Still Required - In some settings everyone, regardless of vaccination status, is still required to wear masks on public transportation (buses, trains, planes, etc.) and some other places (like hospitals and shelters) per CDC guidelines.

People who are not fully vaccinated - Must still wear masks in all indoor public settings (such as, but not limited to, the grocery store and the movie theater) and should wear masks in outdoor crowded settings when that region is experiencing high covid transmission.

Fully vaccinated people - May go unmasked in most settings (except public transportation and places like hospitals and shelters). Workers must follow Cal/OSHA Emergency Temporary Standards.

3. Large Events - Some Restrictions and public health measures are still in place for large, or mega events, which include 5,000+ people indoors or 10,000+ outdoors such as, concerts, sporting events, festivals, and conventions. Mega events are high risk for spreading covid-19 because they attract people from around the world, and people gather in crowds. Indoor mega event attendees will be required to confirm proof of vaccination or negative covid-19 status to attend. Outdoor mega event attendees will be strongly encouraged to do so.
4. This order shall fully lift most executive orders issued under the City’s Emergency Orders. The executive orders to be lifted include the following:


